SITUATION

After several months of negotiations, the District and the SDTA have reached an agreement on a salary increase for the 2005-06 school year. The agreement provides for a salary increase of 2.25% to Schedules A, B, and C. No other changes to the Collective Bargaining Agreement were negotiated at this time.

FISCAL IMPACT

Approximate annual increased cost to general fund for salary increase is \$700,000.

RECOMMENDATION

That the Board of Trustees ratify the agreement with the Sequoia District Teachers Association.

- b. Consideration of Approval of Stipulated Expulsion and Waiver of Expulsion Hearing

SITUATION

On March 16, 2005, a tenth-grade student (name of student to appear in official minutes), committed a serious violation against a district teacher which was a violation of Education Code Sections 48900(a)(1), 48900(b), 48900.4, 48915(b)(1), and 48915(b)(2). The severity of this incident warranted immediate referral for expulsion followed by a mandatory hearing by the Board of Trustees. The student and parents under advice of counsel, waived their rights to a hearing and appeal.

FISCAL IMPACT

RECOMMENDATION

That the Board of Trustees approve the Stipulated Expulsion and Waiver of Expulsion Hearing.

- c. Consideration of Approval of Field Trips

SITUATION

- **Menlo-Atherton Girls Golf Team** to Vacaville, November 6 - 7, 2005, to compete in the CIF Northern California Golf Finals.
- **Menlo-Atherton Outdoors Club** to participate in a one-night camping trip in Big Basin Redwoods State Park, November 12 - 13, 2005, to introduce camping to club members.

FISCAL IMPACT

No fiscal impact on general funds. No student will be denied the opportunity to participate in these field trips due to finances.

RECOMMENDATION

That the Board of Trustees approve the Menlo-Atherton Girls Golf field trip to Vacaville, November 6 - 7, 2005, for the CIF finals and the Menlo-Atherton Outdoors Clubs field trip to Big Basin, November 12 - 13, 2005.
