Sequoia:

- Set-up 6 Mini Computer Labs. Estimated cost \$200,000.
- Infrastructure – Upgrade Electrical System. Estimated Cost \$125,000.
- Infrastructure – New Package Boiler. Estimated Cost \$60,000.

Menlo Atherton:

- Start preliminary investigation work on new theater complex. At this time, MA wants to match initial anticipated donation from Menlo Park estimated between \$50,000 – \$80,000. The SUHSD and the City of Menlo Park are working towards developing a joint use agreement. Menlo Park has already indicated \$2.6 Million that could be used for the project. Estimated cost of a 500-seat theater is \$9-10 Million.

Carlmont:

- Start conceptual work on new theater facility between the main building and the music building. Limited to \$50,000.
- Start conceptual work on new playing area (gym) where the old pool is located. Limited to \$25,000.
- Start design and architectural work on new classroom wing next to the T-building. Number of new classrooms are between 7-12. Estimated cost between \$4-6 Million.
- Infrastructure – High Voltage Power and Switch Gear. Estimated Cost \$400,000.

Woodside:

- The all weather field for Woodside is scheduled for next winter. However, it could work out that it could be done this summer. No guarantees at this time. Estimated cost \$2 Million for track, field, drainage and soft costs.
- Conversion of regular classrooms to science classrooms. This work will not start until the old library renovation is complete. Estimated cost approximately \$600,000 (\$200,000 per classroom).
- Modification of road into school in anticipation of theater project. Estimated cost \$300,000.
- Renovation of video production room. Estimated cost \$100,000.

Redwood:

- Restroom Renovation. Estimated cost \$60,000.
