# Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF)

- Adopted by State Board of Education in 2013
- Replaced old formula (revenue limits) and eliminated most categorical funds
- Intended to allow local stakeholders to have some say on how district's meet the needs of their students



# Local Control <a href="Accountability Plan">Accountability Plan</a> (LCAP)

- Plan of action (3-year rolling plan)
- Process for eliciting input on the district's goals and actions from local stakeholders
- Means to monitor and evaluate the district's progress towards achieving set goals

#### District Must Do's

- Goals aligned to Eight State Priorities
- Use the State Board Adopted LCAP Template
- Adopt every three years and updated annually



#### **LCAP Guidelines**

#### In General:

- Simple
- Transparent
- Local
- Performance-Focused

#### **Budget:**

- Supports how LCFF and LCAP will be used to improve student performance
- Addresses the needs of English Learners, Foster Youth/Homeless and Low Income Students
