NOTICE TO BIDDERS Sequoia Union High School District Menlo Atherton High School

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Sequoia Union High School District ("District") will receive sealed bids for the construction of the Menlo-Atheron HS Locker Room Modernization located at 555 Middlefield Road, Atherton California, 94027 in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by Noll & Tam ("Architect").

This is a state funded project (YES). (Bidders are advised that state funded projects are subject to certain additional conditions, including with respect to prequalification of certain subcontractors, DVBE services, and prevailing wages monitoring through the State Department of Industrial Relations' Compliance Monitoring Unit (CMU), that are more fully described herein.)

1. Time of Opening: Bids will be opened on Tuesday April 24, 2018. Bid documents must be sealed, marked with the project name and bid title. All Bids must be received at the Sequoia Union High School District- Construction Dept. located on 480 James Avenue- Redwood City, CA 94062 BEFORE 2:00 PM on April 24, 2018. Bids which are submitted on or after 2:00 PM or facsimile bid transmissions will not be accepted.

2. Contractors Requirements:

a. All Bidders must have and maintain a Class B contractor's license in order for their bids to be considered responsive. Bidder may bid only on work of a kind for which it is properly licensed by the California Contractors' State License Board. Joint venture Bidders must possess a joint venture license. The Bidder must be licensed at the time of bid and the license must remain current for the duration of the Project. Failure to supply complete license requirement information and signature under penalty of perjury on the bid form may result in the bid being considered non-responsive and rejected.

b. Only pre-qualified contractors may submit bids for this project. Please contact <http://www.seq.org/About-Us/Departments/Construction/index.html> to verify your company's prequalification status. All applications to prequalify must be in writing. The District has retained a third party accountant/auditor to administer the prequalification process and it can take up to three (3) weeks to complete the process, depending on the timeliness and completeness of the application, the number of applications being reviewed, the review process of the application which includes a thorough audit of the financial statements, banking statements and references. A scoring methodology is used and applied objectively on all applications. Potential bidders must allow sufficient time prior to the bid submission date for completion of the prequalification process. Please note that section 20111.6 of the California Public Contract Code requires the prequalification by the District of all electrical, mechanical and plumbing subcontractors on projects involving the use of funds received pursuant to the Leroy F. Greene School Facilities Act of 1998 or from state bond proceeds when the project involves an expenditure of more than \$1 million. It is the Bidder's responsibility to determine whether prequalification of subcontractors is required under this project and, if so, to ensure that Bidder uses only prequalified subcontractors.

c. Section 17076.11 of the California Education Code requires that the District establish a participation goal for disabled veteran business enterprises ("DVBE") of at least three percent (3%) per year of the overall dollar amount of funds allocated to the District by the State Allocation Board and expended by the District for construction and modernization projects. If this project is state funded, the selected contractor shall either meet the three percent DVBE participation goal described in section 17076.11 of the California Education Code OR Contractor shall develop and implement good faith efforts to achieve the three percent participation goal for DVBEs that are reasonably satisfactory to the District. This project REQUIRES DVBE.

d. Pursuant to Senate Bill (SB) 854, all bidders on public works, including any project resulting from this bid process, must register with the California Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) and pay an annual renewal fee to the DIR. Only bidders that have registered with the DIR and that are current in payment of annual renewal fees are eligible to bid as contractors or subcontractors on any project resulting from this bid process. Likewise, only contractors and subcontractors that have registered with the DIR and who are current in payment of their annual renewal fees shall be eligible to receive a contract or subcontract or to perform work under any contracts resulting from this bid process. Pursuant to the California Labor Code, the general prevailing rate of

per diem wages and for Monday and overtime work shall be paid to all workers employed by the contractor selected for this project. Copies of prevailing rates of per diem wages are available upon request at the District's Offices or at www.dir.ca.gov. If this project is state funded, the Department of Industrial Relations will monitor and enforce compliance with applicable prevailing wage requirements on this project through the Compliance Monitoring Unit (CMU) and enforce compliance with applicable prevailing wage requirements in accordance with the California Labor Code, including sections 1771, 1774, 1776, 1777.5, 1813, and 1815. 3. **Duration/Irrevocability of Bids:** All bid proposals submitted shall be considered irrevocable offers to perform the work in accordance with the Contract Documents if a Notice of Award is issued within one hundred twenty (120) days from the date of bid opening.

4. **Plans and Specifications:** Plans and specifications for the above mentioned project will be available April 3, 2018. 5. **Inspection of Site and Investigation of Applicable Regulations; Pre-Bid Site Inspection and Conference.** Mandatory pre-bid site inspections and conferences will be held at Menlo Atherton HS on Tuesday, April 10, 2018. All attendees are to meet outside in front of the Administration building 555 Middlefield Road, Atherton, CA 94027 at 10:00am. Attendees must sign in by scheduled time. The District shall have the discretion to bar attendees who fail to arrive by scheduled time from signing in if the circumstances warrant. Failure to attend the mandatory pre-bid site inspections will render the Bidder non-responsive. Before submitting a bid proposal, Bidders shall examine the drawings, read the specifications, the form of Agreement, and other Contract Documents. They shall visit the site of the proposed Project; examine the building, or buildings, if any, and any work that may have been done thereon. They shall fully inform themselves of all conditions on, in, at, and about the site, the buildings, if any, and any work that may have been done thereon. All Bidders shall inform themselves of all applicable statutory or regulations authorities that may impact work under the Project, including, but not limited to, local noise ordinances and other local regulation that may limit work hours or equipment used on site.
