NOTICE TO GENERAL AND MEP CONTRACTORS CALLING FOR PRE-QUALIFICATION APPLICATIONS FOR 2017

California Assembly Bill (AB) 1565 went into effect on January 1, 2014.

AB 1565 requires ALL General Contractors and M/E/P Subcontractors be pre-qualified if the contract is valued at \$1 million or more and funded whole or in part with State Facility Bond funds. This applies to the following license numbers:

- General Contractors (A and B)
- Mechanical, Engineering, and Plumbing Contractor and Subcontractors ("MEPs"): C-4, C-7, C-10, C-16, C-20, C-34, C-36, C-38, C-42, C-43, and C-46

It is mandatory that all General Contractors and M/E/P Subcontractors who intend to submit a bid to the District or to a qualified General Contractor fully complete the prequalification questionnaire, provide all materials requested herein, and be approved by the District to be on the qualified Bidders and MEP subcontractor list. Upcoming projects will be posted on the District website <u>www.seq.org</u> (construction department). Prequalified bidders may choose to bid any or all of the projects for which they are prequalified.

The District requests that applications be submitted by a deadline of January 15, 2017.

The District reserves the right to reject any or all responses to a Pre-qualification Questionnaire and to waive irregularities in responses received. The District also reserves the right to solicit bids from outside of the pre-qualified pool if determined by the District to be in its best interest.

All information submitted for pre-qualification evaluation (questionnaire answers and financial statements), are not public records and are not open to public inspection. All information provided will be kept confidential to the extent permitted by law.
